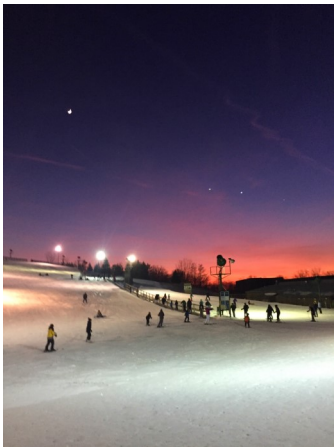

Patch Program

All club members agree to participate in a progressive lesson program. Lift tickets are restricted, meaning it is a beginner area ticket (Wonder Carpet lift and Rope Tow) until lessons are passed and patches are purchased. The patches indicate to our lift operators when students are proficient enough to ride on the chairlifts. Skiing and riding with a parent does not entitle a student to ski wherever their parent takes them. The child must pass the appropriate lesson.

Lessons are 50 minutes and start at 5:00 or 6:30 p.m. at Pine Knob –or– 5:00 or 6:00 p.m. at Mt. Holly. Please inform your students to stand in line at the flag that corresponds to the color of patch they are trying to earn. They should have their lesson tickets ready. ***Please note: A patch is not earned on the first lesson.**
